

# Sheffield Ale Pubs

## Pub Walk No 11 – Dore to Totley

A friend of mine said where is **Pub Walk No11** so I decided to put this one on Twitter and gave them 4 options and the winner was a trip from Dore right through to Totley, I knew which pubs they were going to be but not sure on how to get to Totley, in the end it proved to be an easy route.

I also picked a Saturday as it will be a rush for an evening walk and in the summer time, I picked a belter of a hot day to do this, t-shirt day it was, so best do it on a weekend and enjoy the beer gardens that all these pubs have.

You can catch the 272 but to the first pub.

Pub 1 – [Dore Moor Inn](#) – a lovely nice large pub set off the main road, plenty of seating inside the pub with some tables set aside for food, they do have a beer garden at the front and side of the pub, they serve 3 ales here.



Pub 2 – [Devonshire Arms](#) – to get to this pub it is a short walk into Dore village, this was the first time I have been in this pub and again plenty of seats inside they have a beer garden at the front and side of the pub, landlady was very pleasant, they serve local ales here won their 6 ale pumps.



Pub 3 – [Hare & Hounds](#), this pub you can see from Pub No 2 and also has a lot of seating inside and you will find 6 ale pumps although they do repeat on more than one pump, they also have a beer garden, local ales are in here along with Doombar.



Pub 4 – [The Cricket Inn](#), to get to this pub you walk down the front side of Pub 3 and keep walking on this road, the footpath will suddenly disappear and in front of you will see a footpath leading into a field, walk down this footpath and follow it, you will go through a farm and it will take you to this pub, you will see it as you walk through the field. This is a Thornbridge pub serving 4 cask pumps and they also have some keg lines, food is also served here and they have a beer garden overlooking a cricket field.



Pub 5 – [The Crown Inn](#) – walk out of pub 4 and walk down the road, do not go up any footpaths as you will walk past the pub (I did this) and when you get to the end of the road turn right and walk up the hill, you will bump into this pub. Lovely pub inside with the bar in front as you walk into the pub and seating area either side, beer garden outside. 4 ales are on and again local ales being served.



Pub 6 – [The Cross Scythes](#) – if you walk up the hill from Pub5 and turn left you will come to this very large pub, plenty of seating inside and they serve food, beer garden at the back of the pub and some tables at the front, 4 ales are served here and a nice range is available.



Pub 7 – [Shepley Spitfire](#) – If you walk down the road from Pub6 and turn right at Mickely Lane and follow this road and you will come to this Greene King pub, beer garden is at the back of the pub and they serve 6 ales, mostly are their own but I did get a Castle Rock ale in here.



This completes the Dore & Totley walk, it is idea for a warm summers Saturday walk.

You can if you wish catch the 97 bus and get off at The **Broadfield** and **Hop Hideout** and spend some time in these places, I did Plus you are also a short walk to Heeley pubs – Tramshed, White Lion, Sheaf View and Brothers Arms.
